



Seminar 18 December 2021 from 10:00 to 14:00

Twenty months of a pandemic means a big change in our personal lives and in society. Or maybe not.

In this seminar, we would like to explore the question of what changes the global Covid19 situation has brought with it. We propose to analyse the personal dimension and the social impact. We want to clarify together whether the experience of pain has enabled us to strengthen our inner and outer values.

The aim of the project is to create a community and bring about changes of a spiritual nature in which the value of things and human interactions can be recognised both individually and as a group.

This seminar will have a different character than what is usual in a seminar. There will be no lectures. From the facilitation table, everyone will be invited to share their testimony, their experience, to realise together what this pandemic is causing. It is likely that in a world that is coming apart at the seams, even more difficult situations lie ahead.

In September 2020, we conducted a survey with EIFI, CESFN, Uniterra and personal contacts. Fifty people responded on the basis of three questions: What are people talking about in your environment? What concerns do they reflect? And what changes do they provoke? There was no opportunity to comment on these questions. This seminar is intended to be a space for communication about what has happened. It will take place in presence at the CESFN and is open to all interested parties. The presence of those who took part in the survey in particular would be a good contribution.

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
